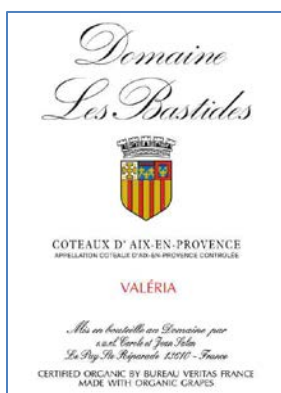

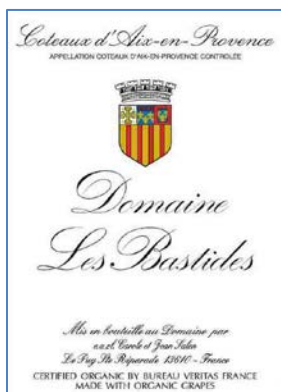
Côteaux D'Aix-en-Provence

Maturing, but still has guts, with a beefy edge to the core of plum, black currant and fig fruit. Ample worn leather and dark tobacco notes hold sway through the finish. A charcoal spine is well-buried throughout. Cabernet Sauvignon and Grenache. Drink now through 2020. 1,100 cases made.

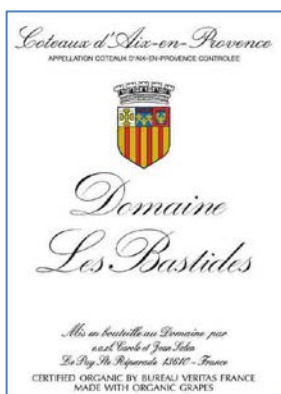

Ripe and racy, with a beautiful beam of distilled plum and red currant fruit racing through, inlaid with ample violet, rosemary and singed juniper accents. The long finish has excellent drive, showing an echo of warm paving stone. Grenache and Cabernet Sauvignon. Drink now through 2020. 3,000 cases made.

Côteaux D'Aix-en-Provence Rosé de Saignée 2015

An excellent wine with it deeper color leading to a nicely vinous and complex bouquet of cherries, rhubarb, a touch of garrigue and a lovely base of soil tones. On the palate the wine is deep, full-bodied, crisp and complex, with a fine core, bright acids and a very long, serious finish. The cépages here are primarily grenache and cinsault, with a touch of mourvèdre in the mix. Fine juice and really good at the table in the summer months. 2017-2019.
