GROWING REGION:

Langhe, Monforte d'Alba, Piemonte, Italy.

TERROIR:

Grapes primarily from one-acre parcel of Nebbiolo planted in 2002. East-facing at 1,400 feet above sea level in sandy loam.

GRAPES:

100% Nebbiolo.

VITICULTURE NOTES:

Organic: minimal copper and sulfur additions.
Harvested by hand.

VINIFICATION NOTES:

Blend of *saignée* and direct press (50/50).
Elevage in steel for 4 months. 200 cases annually.

TASTING NOTES:

This rosato is a great summer wine, but it has substance and class that allows it to age well for a couple of years. Ideal as an apéritif, it also pairs well with shellfish and starters.
