GROWING REGION:

Columbia Valley, Oregon.

TERROIR:

Old-vine Chenin with over 35 years of own-rooted development at the highest elevation in the north central Yakima. Soil made of quartz and lime silica overlaid with sedimentary runoff of Missoula floods.

GRAPES:

Chenin Blanc.

VINIFICATION NOTES:

Native yeast ferment, aged sur lie in neutral barrels.

TASTING NOTES:

A Villages wine with laser-like precision dominated by the classic Chenin beeswax and lanolin. Palate full of minerality.
