ROSÉ OF GAMAY NOIR "L'AVOIRON"



GROWING REGION:

Willard Farms, Columbia Valley, Washington.

TERROIR:

Volcanic, basalt, quartz and lime silica and loam sedimentary soils.

GRAPES:

100% Gamay Noir.

VINIFICATION NOTES:

Half of the grapes were destemmed for color and the other half left whole cluster. Both portions were pressed together, then fermented in stainless steel vats for two months. 525 cases.

TASTING NOTES:

This wine is light and ethereal - similar to a Corsican style rosé. The color is very light pink with hints of copper. The intense aromatics scream strawberry creamsicle with a touch of citrus. The palate is delicate and very long with distinct frozen red berries.
