GROWING REGION:

Eola Amity Hills, Oregon

TERROIR:

Methven Family Vineyards (40%)

Marine sedimentary

Bethany Heights Vineyard (40%)

Volcanic

Bjornson Vineyard (20%)

Red clay

GRAPES:

100% Pinot Noir

VINIFICATION NOTES:

The Methven and Bethany Heights grapes were whole-cluster pressed and then left on the skins in the press for about 5 hours before being fermented in large stainless steel tank. The Bjornson grapes were foot-stomped and then fermented in neutral French oak barrels. 125 cases.

TASTING NOTES:

This wine has a profile much like a rosé from the Loire's Sancerre with distinct briny minerality running through its core. The upper layers showcase nice floral and strawberry fruit characteristics. Light and crisp, the wine is refreshing when young, but definitely evolves with time.
