GROWING REGION:

Champagne, France
Côte des Blancs: Cramant

TERROIR:

Grand cru vines in Cramant, Chouilly and Oiry on the chalk flank of the Côte des Blancs. 8.64 acres.

GRAPES:

Chardonnay.

VINIFICATION NOTES:

Made entirely from first pressing (second pressing is sold to Moët) from three consecutive vintages. Tank fermentation, full malo, aging on lees in bottle for three years. Ripe fruit thus low dosage. Annual production 1,650 cases.

TASTING NOTES:

A beautiful and classic expression of Chardonnay. White flowers, hay, taut green apples, spice, and incisive chalkiness.
