GROWING REGION:

Bergerac, Southwest, France.

TERROIR:

Clay-limestone soil on Southwest-facing hillsides. 200 meters of elevation.

GRAPES:

Semillon 60%, Sauvignon 35%, Muscadelle 5%.

VITICULTURE NOTES:

Certified organic.

VINIFICATION NOTES:

Raised in steel. Annual production just over 4,000 cases.

TASTING NOTES:

A beguiling white with a fresh, clean nose and a succulent middle thanks to the Semillon. A great value.

GROWING REGION:

Bergerac, Southwest, France.

TERROIR:

Clay-limestone soil on Southwest-facing hill-sides. 200 meters of elevation.

GRAPES:

Merlot 90%, Cabernet Sauvignon 10%.

VITICULTURE NOTES:

Certified organic.

VINIFICATION NOTES:

Raised in steel. Annual production just over 4,000 cases.

TASTING NOTES:

A wine with a rich core of blackberry and cassis fruit, sumptuously full bodied. A great value.
