Morgon Côte du Py 2018

The Côte du Py bottling from the Depardon family hails from their three hectares of vines on the summit of the vineyard. The grapes are destemmed, fermented with indigenous yeasts and raised entirely in old foudres prior to bottling. The 2018 Côte du Py delivers a refined bouquet of red and black cherries, gamebird, a bit of espresso, lovely minerality, a dollop of fresh thyme and a smoky topnote. On the palate the wine is pure, full-bodied and beautifully transparent in personality (particularly for 2018), with a fine core of fruit, ripe, buried tannins and a long, complex and beautifully balanced finish. This is an excellent example of Côte du Py. 2020- 2055+.
