

DOMAINE LECOINTRE
ANJOU ROUGE AVANT-GARDE



GROWING REGION:

Anjou, Loire Valley, France.

TERROIR:

From two parcels in the schist soils of Champ-sur-Layon in the heart of Anjou totaling nearly ten and a half acres, one planted in 1997 and the other in 2007.

GRAPES:

Cabernet Franc.

VINIFICATION NOTES:

Raised in tank. Certified organic. 500 cases annually.

TASTING NOTES:

Meant to be drunk young with a light chill. A *vin de soif*.

DOMAINE LECOINTRE

CUVÉE RUE DU PINEAU D' AUNIS



GROWING REGION:

Anjou, Loire Valley, France.

TERROIR:

From a parcel of just over 4 acres planted in 1960 in the schist soils of Champ-sur-Layon, in the heart of Anjou.

GRAPES:

Pineau d'Aunis (once beloved by kings, but now rather rare apart from scattered old-vine plantings).

VINIFICATION NOTES:

Raised in tank. No addition of sulfites, even at bottling. Certified organic. 200 cases annually.

TASTING NOTES:

A vin de soif with peppery spice and lightweight, full flavors.
