



# **GROWING REGION:**

Anjou, Loire Valley, France.

### **TERROIR:**

From two parcels in the schist soils of Champ-sur-Layon in the heart of Anjou totaling nearly ten and a half acres, one planted in 1997 and the other in 2007.

## **GRAPES:**

Cabernet Franc.

### **VINIFICATION NOTES:**

Raised in tank. Certified organic. 500 cases annually.

### TASTING NOTES:

Meant to be drunk young with a light chill. A *vin de soif*.





# GROWING REGION:

Anjou, Loire Valley, France.

### **TERROIR:**

From a parcel of just over 4 acres planted in 1960 in the schist soils of Champ-sur-Layon, in the heart of Anjou.

### **GRAPES:**

Pineau d'Aunis (once beloved by kings, but now rather rare apart from scattered old-vine plantings).

### **VINIFICATION NOTES:**

Raised in tank. No addition of sulfites, even at bot - tling. Certified organic. 200 cases annually.

## **TASTING NOTES:**

A *vin de soif* with peppery spice and lightweight, full flavors.
