LE CIEL VIDE



**GROWING REGION:**

Roussillon, France, bordering Spain on the Mediterranean.

**TERROIR:**

Vineyards tight up against the Pyrenees in Roussillon, the sunniest viticultural area in France, but also in the path of the cooling and ripening-retarding Tramonte wind. Limestone-clay soils.

**GRAPES:**

Syrah, Mourvèdre, Grenache.

**VINIFICATION NOTES:**

Raised in tank. 200-500 cases.

**TASTING NOTES:**

Crunchy forest fruits and an earthy, smoky character. This is the domaine's homage to 9/11, inspired by a Bruce Springsteen song.

# DOMAINE TRELOAR

## THREE PEAKS

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### **GROWING REGION:**

Roussillon, France, bordering Spain on the Mediterranean.

### **TERROIR:**

Named after the three peaks in the Pyrenees that tower over the vines. Soil is rich in clay and laced with stones.

### **GRAPES:**

60% Syrah, 30% Mourvèdre, 20% Grenache.

### **VINIFICATION NOTES:**

Aged mostly in tank with some older wood.  
650 cases.

### **TASTING NOTES:**

Rich and spicy with dark fruit flavors. Complex with good structure and body.

# DOMAINE TRELOAR

## MOTUS

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### **GROWING REGION:**

Roussillon, France, bordering Spain on the Mediterranean.

### **TERROIR:**

Vineyards tight up against the Pyrenees in Roussillon, the sunniest viticultural area in France, but also in the path of the cooling and ripening-retarding Tramonte wind. From a 3-acre parcel in limestone-clay soils.

### **GRAPES:**

80% Mourvèdre, 15% Syrah, 5% Grenache.

### **VINIFICATION NOTES:**

Raised entirely in barrel with roughly 20% new wood. 400 6-packs.

### **TASTING NOTES:**

A wine lover's wine. An age-worthy cuvée that is round with a toasty complexity to the underlying wild berries and hint of musroom.
