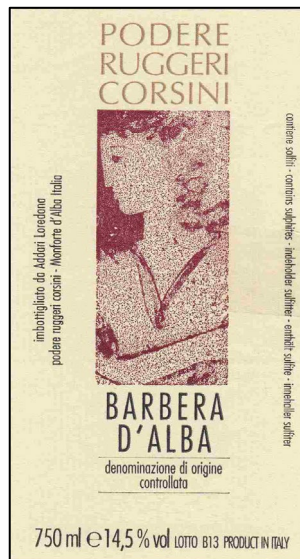

Langhe Barbera d'Alba 2019

The 2019 Barbera from Nicola and Lorendana Argamante is a beautiful example of this underrated variety, coming in at fourteen percent octane in this vintage and raised entirely in stainless steel tanks prior to bottling without fining or filtration. The wine offers up a lovely, complex aromatic constellation of red and black cherries, a touch of peanut, woodsmoke, fresh oregano, a beautiful base of soil tones and a nice touch of road tar. On the palate the wine is bright, bouncy and full-bodied, with lovely transparency down to the soil, a good core, tangy acids and just a touch of backend tannin on the long and nicely balanced finish. This is really quite lovely Barbera that will age quite gracefully. 2022-2035.
