Langhe Barolo San Pietro 2017

Bricco San Pietro is a high altitude vineyard in Monforte, with fairly sandy soils that produce a quite elegant example of Barolo. Proprietor Nicola Argamante chooses to raise this wine entirely in older, Slavonian oak botti prior to bottling. The 2017 Bricco San Pietro is a lovely bottle in the making, offering up a refined bouquet of cherries, gamebird, road tar, woodsmoke, a touch of oregano, a complex base of soil tones and a topnote of rose petals. On the palate the wine is deep, full-bodied and rock solid at the core, with firm, ripe tannins, tangy acids and excellent mineral drive on the long, very well-balanced finish. This is a beautiful bottle of old school Barolo in the making, with exceptional backend lift and energy. It will need plenty of time in the cellar to soften up, but once it is ready to drink, it will deliver decades of excellence. 2035-2085.
