

Langhe Rosato Rosin 2021

The Langhe Rosato bottling from Podere Ruggeri Corsini is made entirely from nebbiolo. The wine is raised in tank. It is a pretty salmon color and offers up a bright and complex bouquet of tangerine, rhubarb, chalky soil tones, cherry skin, dried flowers and a topnote of orange peel. On the palate the wine is deep, full-bodied, focused and complex, with a rock solid core of fruit, lovely soil signature and grip, zesty acids, a whisper of tannin and a long, well-balanced finish. This is an excellent Rosato that is most emphatically a food wine, with the depth and backend grip one associates with red wines made from this varietal. Fine, fine juice. 2022-2035.
