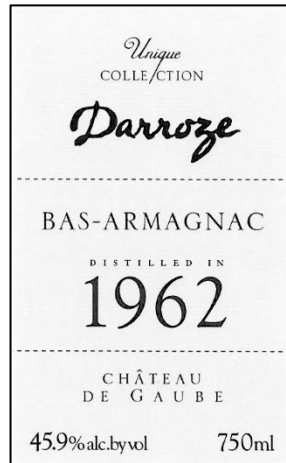

Gaube '62 Bas Armagnac

Still young, with notes of candied fruits, sweet spices, varnish. The palate is very dashing, lively, with great tone and well-balanced fire, a nice length: this Armagnac seems eternal.

Gaube '66 Bas Armagnac

A nose of great allure, with roasted fruit, ginger, complex and evolving in the glass. Ample mouthfeel, with fatness, enveloping the tannins, an aromatic expression that lingers. The bottom of the glass evolves further on more complexity.

Martin '01 Bas Armagnac

A fine and elegant nose with aromas of dried flowers, candied lemon and anise. The mouth is balanced with a beautiful aromatic complexity, and an alcohol masked by the substance, an already mellowed woodiness.
