## Savigny-les-Beaune

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### **Bourgogne Blanc 2021**

*Serrigny's Bourgogne Blanc vines are located primarily in the village of Meursault, but with a small percentage of the blend hailing from the very chalky lieu dit of les Perrières in Savigny, where Domaine Simon Bize makes a single vineyard bottling. The 2021 version is a beautifully classic example in the making, offering up a bright bouquet of green apple, lemon, chalky soil tones, beeswax and a nice touch of lime peel. On the palate the wine is bright, full bodied and complex, with a good core, lovely, zesty acidity, fine balance and a long, soil-driven finish. A lovely example in the making. 2024-2035.*

### **Savigny-les-Beaune Blanc 2021**

*The 2021 Savigny-les-Beaune Blanc from Marie-Laure Serrigny is going to be outstanding. It will probably want a year or two in the cellar to fully blossom, but once it does, it is going to offer excellent breed and complexity. The bouquet delivers scents of lemon, sweet quince, chalky minerality, a touch of fresh almond, spring flowers and a deft touch of vanillin oak. On the palate the wine is pure, full-bodied, long and soil-driven, with a lovely core, a fine girdle of acidity and a precise, focused and complex finish. Fine juice. 2024-2040+.*

### **Savigny-les-Beaune 1er Cru "La Dominode" 2021**

*The 2021 la Dominode is going to be outstanding and quite classical in profile. The lovely bouquet wafts from the glass in a youthful blend of cherries red currants, pomegranate, gamebird, a superb base of soil tones, coffee, Savigny spices, just a touch of oak and a floral topnote redolent of roses. On the palate the wine is pure, full-bodied and svelte in profile, with a lovely core of fruit, excellent mineral drive, ripe, fine-grained tannins and a long, complex and impeccably balanced finish. In terms of absolute quality, the 2021 la Dominode is only a nod superior to the 2019, but in terms of style, I have a preference for the utterly classical personality of the 2021 version. 2031-2075.*
