CHÂTEAU JAMARD BELCOUR LUSSAC SAINT-EMILION





GROWING REGION:

Lussac Saint-Emilion, Bordeaux, France.

GRAPES:

90% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc.

TERROIR:

Lussac is the northernmost of the Saint-Emilion satellites. This comes from 4 parcels of mature vines (45 year average) on one hillside of clay-limestone soils.

VINIFICATION NOTES:

Native ferments in above-ground concrete vats with 12 months of aging in underground concrete vats. No fining, light filtration. 2,600 cases.

TASTING NOTES:

Nose is intensely earthy and terroir-driven. With air, red and black fruits emerge with limestone lift. A full-bodied, elegant wine.
