

DOMAINE HENRY NATTER
SANCERRE

Sauvignon Blanc from vines in Kimmeridgian limestone soils. Native yeast fermentation in huge old wood foudres. Ages a minimum of 6 months. 8,500 cases annually. Intense aromas, rich texture, roundness and elegance on the palate.

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SANCERRE ROUGE

A quintessential Pinot Noir from Sancerre's Kimmeridgian limestone soils. From 10 acres of vines. Alcoholic fermentation in tank and then aged 18 months in barrels, mostly older wood.

Complex and fruity with substantial mineral and earth aromas. Characterful and lifted.



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SANCERRE FRANÇOIS DE LA GRANGE

Sauvignon Blanc from the Natter family's oldest vines, planted in the mid-1970s in Sancerre's famous Kimmeridgian limestone soils and farmed sustainably. Aged in huge old oak casks for 9-12 months. 1,650 cases annually.

A wine with great texture and richness, driving acidity and length. Designed for long cellaring.



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
