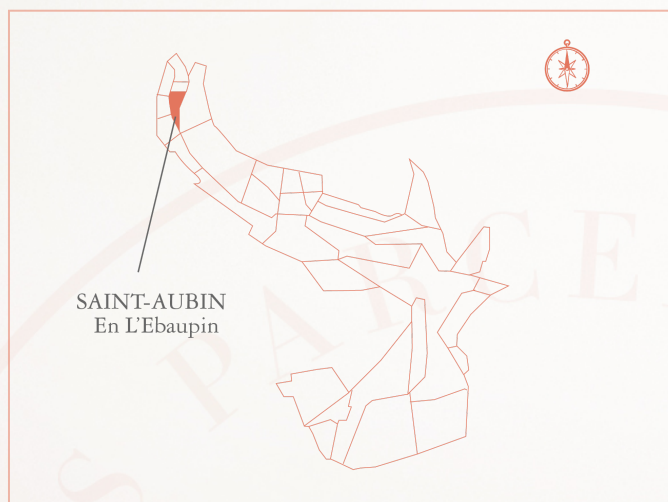
COMPLEX AND AMPLE

## THIS "CLIMAT"

Its name comes from the hawthorn, a thorny shrub with white flowers that previously covered this plot.

## TERROIR

Facing to the south on the sloping hillside which joins La Rochepot, with blond hearth and stones.



## TASTING

Apparence : Pale yellow with brilliant tints.

Bouquet : Complex nose of toasted hazelnut, vanilla, flint and linden.

In the mouth : Full and balanced with hints of almond paste. A nice freshness and minerality on the finish.



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
