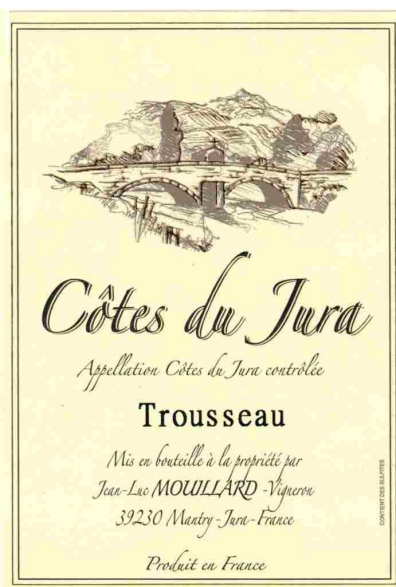


Domaine Jean-Luc Mouillard

Jean-Luc Mouillard raises his Trousseau in either older barrels or stainless steel tanks, depending on the style of the vintage, with the lighter years raised in tank. His 2022 was given an élevage in casks. The wine is vibrant on both the nose and palate this year, offering up a complex bouquet of cherries, a touch of pomegranate, fresh herb tones, bonfire, a hint of anise and a beautiful bassline of limestone minerality. On the palate the wine is deep, full-bodied and beautifully transparent in personality, with a lovely core of red fruit, superb mineral drive and grip, firm, ripe tannins and excellent focus and balance on the long, complex and very promising finish. This will demand some cellaring time to soften up its tannins, but it is going to be excellent in due course. 2031-2075+.
