### Côtes du Roussillon “Motus” 2019

*Jonathan Hesford is always challenging the status quo and this Mourvèdre based wine encapsulates this. Powerful, concentrated, blueberry, fig with some garrigue and a fine touch of dill spice from ageing in 20% American oak. Jonathan likes the blood character of this wine and although a big style it has refined tannins and great control. A real Aspres wine. 2023-2030.*

### Côtes du Roussillon “Motus” 2017

*The 2017 Côtes du Roussillon Villages “Motus” bottling from Domaine Treloar is mostly comprised of old vine mourvèdre, with eighty percent of the cuvée made from this grape in 2017. This is augmented by fifteen percent syrah and five percent grenache, with the wine raised entirely in barrel, with twenty percent of the casks renewed each year. The wine is excellent in 2017, offering up a pure and complex nose of cassis, dark berries, smoked meats, chalky soil tones, a bit of tree bark, lovely spice tones and a topnote of bonfire. On the palate the wine is bright, full-bodied, focused and complex, with a fine core of fruit, lovely mineral drive, ripe tannins and a long, tangy and very well-balanced finish. This comes in listed at fourteen percent alcohol in this vintage and has plenty of depth, but the overall impression is one of refinement. Fine, fine juice that needs a handful of years in the cellar to further soften up its tannins and start to drink with generosity. 2027-2050.*

*Smells of wild-boar saucisson and hot tar and blue berries and pepper. Tastes of wild blackberries, campfire embers in cool milky dawn, fridge-cold morels, rain on slate, cola, smoke, black-pepper syrup. I love the fierce, bright Tellicherry peppercorn character that seems to be stippled into the bones of this wine. It gives it such remarkable freshness. A wine that is begging for coal-grilled red meat and roasted veg, loaded with resin-fragrant, woody herbs. Long and muscular. **Good Value.***
