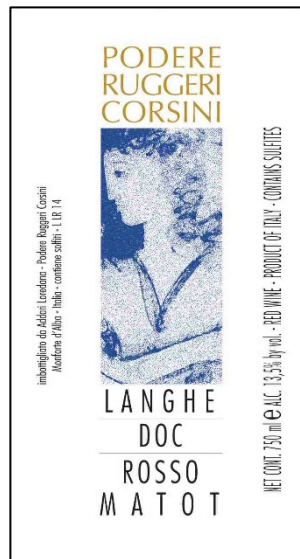

Langhe Rosso Matot 2021

Matot is a blended red wine from Loredana Addari and Nicola Argamante, with the primary building block of the blend here being Dolcetto. However, it also includes younger vine production of Nebbiolo, Barbera, Albarossa and Pinot Nero. All of the grapes are grown in their Monforte vineyards, with the idea to make this blended wine and keep the average age of the vines going into their other bottlings that much older. The 2021 Matot tips the scales at 13.5 percent alcohol in this vintage and delivers a lovely nose of dark berries, black cherries, road tar, espresso, a dollop of fresh herbs and plenty of upper register smokiness. On the palate the wine is vibrant, full-bodied and complex, with a lovely core of black fruit, buried, moderate tannins and fine length and grip on the well balanced and crunchy finish. This is a lovely wine. 2025-2045.
