



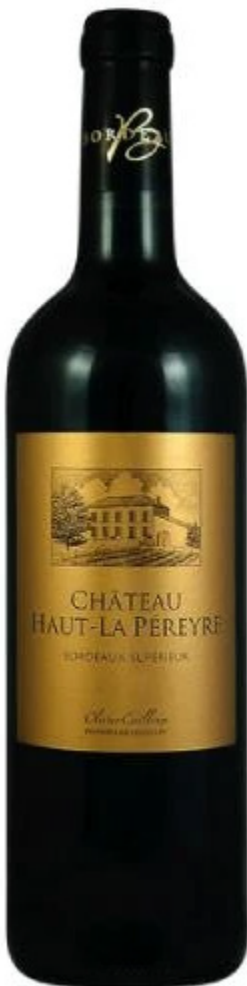
# HAUT-LA PÉREYRE BORDEAUX SUPÉRIEUR ROUGE

certified sustainable (HVE)

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This domaine started life in 1881 in the prestigious albeit small appellation of Haut-Benauges in Bordeaux's Entre-Deux-Mers region. It's a family domaine of 126 acres, and today Olivier Cailleux is the 6th generation to manage it.

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## VINEYARD

- Site:** Olivier reserves several of his best parcels for this Bordeaux Supérieur. The vines grow in the hills in the hinterland back of the ancient river town of Cadillac.
- Soil:** France's classic mix of clay and limestone with excellent drainage and exposure (no lack of hills in Haut-Benauges!).
- Vines:** From 20 acres in organic conversion. Currently HVE certified.
- Varieties:** Three-quarters Merlot, one-quarter Cabernet Sauvignon.

## CELLAR

- Élevage:** Aged 16 months in stainless steel tanks.
- Bottling:** No fining and only a light filtration at bottling.
- Production:** 4,500 cases.
- Profile:** This is a wine with aromas of graphite and earth that speak clearly of classical Bordeaux. It's delicious, immensely drinkable, and a great value.
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
