



Langhe Nebbiolo 2021

Giuseppe Nada's 2021 Langhe Nebbiolo bottling is made from his younger vines in his Barbaresco vineyards in the township of Treiso. The wine comes in at a classic fourteen percent octane in this vintage and delivers a beautifully refined aromatic constellation of cherries, gamebird, a touch of anise, a lovely base of soil tones, fresh oregano, red curry and a topnote of bonfire. On the palate the wine is bright, fullbodied and complex, with tangy acids, fine depth at the core, good soil transparency, moderate tannins and a long, focused and nicely balanced finish. This is lovely juice that I would opt for aging three to five years before drinking, but is certainly approachable with the right food today, if given a short decant. 2023-2045+.
