

Orion Chablis



The Wines

- *Petit Chablis*: One hectare (2.5 acres) of Chardonnay planted in 1988 and facing north in the lieu-dit of Les Temps Perdue. Native ferments and élevage in steel. Light fining and filtering. Production: 4,000 bottles.
- *Chablis*: Nearly two hectares (5 acres) of Chardonnay planted in 1978 and facing south off the road to Chablis. The second year of production—2020—Andy Howard MW reviewed this vintage of Orion Chablis in Decanter Magazine and gave it a score of 92. Like the Petit, this ferments spontaneously in steel and is raised entirely in steel. Light fining and filtering. Production: 10,000 bottles.
