Chablis 2022

In bottle in March because of lack of stock. Fresh pale lemon yellow. The bouquet is more in the fresh saline style, but with a good weight of ripe apple fruit behind. Very coherent on the palate, not too ripe, stones to finish, all agreeable. Drink from 2024-2027. Tasted: July 2023.

89 pts- Jasper Morris, December 2023

The 2022 Chablis Village, raised in stainless steel, has a terse but focused bouquet that opens nicely in the glass, demonstrating more mineralité than its peers. The palate is fresh and vibrant on the entry, with fine depth given its status. There's well-judged acidity with an energetic, saline finish. Enjoy this over the next 4-6 years.

Chablis Mont de Milieu 1er Cru 2022

A fuller lemon yellow. Not much bouquet at first. Glorious harmony on the palate with a few wood tannins which help the structure at the back, but in fruit terms, the wine absolutely wins through. Fresh yellow plums, ripe but not exaggerated. This is impressive. And with a crispness at the finish which I like a lot, given the body weight of the wine. Drink from 2027-2035.
