I love the complex spicy nose of this exceptional Alsace pinot noir with its notes of clove, allspice and cardamon, plus a slew of wild berry aromas. Excellent concentration with abundant fine tannins, giving this a velvety mouthfeel on the midpalate, then a great silkiness at the crescendo finish. A stunning result for vines that are just 15 years old! From organically grown grapes with Fair of Green certification.

The 2020 Pinot Noir Hüt is from Hütte, a plot directly to the east of Engelberg, with the same oolitic limestone but with more clay and is south-facing. The vines are roughly 15 years old. Smoke and earth immediately signal more power on the nose. A hint of creaminess follows. The palate is restrained for such a warm vintage. There is great accord and balance between tannin, fruit and freshness backed by a very smooth structure. The slightly extracted tannins are as mouth-watering as the freshness. Balanced and sonorous, this is a bigger wine destined for the table and autumnal, resonant, earthy foods. Matured in one-year-old barrels from Méo-Camuzet.
