The family of Giuseppe Nada has been farming grapes in Barbaresco for generations. The domaine is in Treiso, the highest of the appellation's communes, and the family tends just over 15 very steep acres of organic vines.

Giuseppe's dynamic son Enrico took over in 2008 and runs the estate with his sister and his nephew.



VINEYARD

Site: From the hills of Diano d'Alba, effectively between the Barbaresco and Barolo appellations.

Soil: Clay, calcareous marls and chalk.

Vines: Just over 2 acres of vines planted in the 1980s. Certified organic.

Varieties: Dolcetto.

CELLAR

Élevage: A short maceration followed by spontaneous ferments in steel; 6-8 months aging in steel. Minimal SO₂, no fining and only a light filtration.

Production: ~300 cases.

Profile: Vintage 2021 made for a wine of extraordinary fruit.
