

## NADA LANGHE RIESLING TECUM

## certified organic

The family of Giuseppe Nada has been farming grapes in Barbaresco for generations. The domaine is in Treiso, the highest of the appellation's communes, and the family tends just over 15 very steep acres of organic wines. Giuseppe's dynamic son Enrico took over in 2008 and runs the estate with his sister and his nephew.



## **VINEYARD**

Site: From the top of the Marcarini hillside: the first two rows at the

top of the long hill, sheltered from the afternoon sun by the winery; and a second parcel just a bit further downslope. This northeast-facing hillside makes for excellent acid retention in

the grapes.

**Soil:** Clay, calcareous marls and chalk.

Vines: From two parcels planted in 2011. Certified organic.

Varieties: Riesling.

**CELLAR** 

Élevage: Aged 6 months on the lies in steel and then matured in bottle

for 3 years before being released. No fining and only a light

filtration. Minimal SO2 addition.

**Production:** 150 cases.

Profile: Similar to a dry Alsatian Riesling. Fresh and complex with

notable minerality. *Tecum* is Latin for *with you*.
