This domaine started life in 1881 in the prestigious, albeit small appellation of Haut-Benauges in Bordeaux's Entre-Deux-Mers region. It's a family domaine of 126 acres, and today Olivier Cailleux is the 6th generation to manage it.

VINEYARD



- Site:** The vines grow in the hills in the hinterland back of the ancient walled river town of Cadillac. Here, Olivier reserves his finest sites for this classic red Bordeaux.
- Elevation:** On the best exposed and higher slopes, reaching more than 100 meters.
- Soil:** Gravelly-clay slopes and sandy-clay plateau.
- Vines:** From 12 acres on three parcels, all High Environmental Value (HVE) certified and in organic conversion.
- Varieties:** 65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot, 10% Petit Verdot.

CELLAR

- Élevage:** Aged 18 months in stainless steel tanks and a mix of old and new 500L French oak barrels.
- Bottling:** No fining or only a light filtration.
- Production:** 1,700 cases.
- Profile:** A deliciously tempered Bordeaux with a decidedly classic profile. Rich, savory, focused and structured. Great price/quality ratio. *Meste-Jean*, or Master John, is the name of the land where Olivier Cailleux's great grandfather farmed grapes.
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
