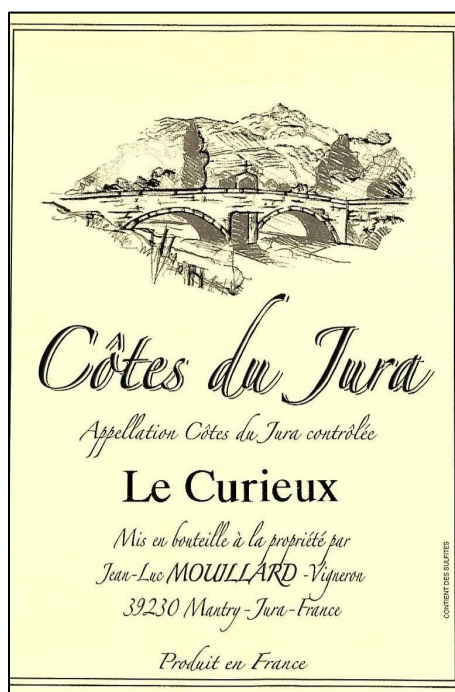


Domaine Jean-Luc Mouillard

100% Savagnin, *ouillé*, aged in French oak. This 11-ha estate has been sustainably farmed for years and is currently in conversion to organic certification. It will be certified this year (2023).

*Such an interesting nose. Smells of sour cream, acacia blossom, goat-milk butter. With a bit of toastiness – like thickly buttered toast popped under the grill until dark golden brown. The wine is almost rigidly, shockingly mineral. The very first impression is its white-citrus-drenched, firm, three-dimensional structure. It's dramatic, uncompromising. But this is not a severe wine. Every space is filled with chamomile flowers, talc, bergamot, quinine bitters, brine. The fruit may taste like green peaches but it comes with an implosion of sherbet. It reverberates with its own electric current and fills every space, every corner, every pause. **GV***
