This wood-aged wine, with equal quantities of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, is full of blackberry flavors, edged by tannins and with a rounded, fruity aftertaste. It is a blend from three specific plots in the 12-acre vineyard. Drink this fine wine from 2024.

This six-generation estate in the Entre-deux-Mers region has produced a richly structured wine. With a juicy backdrop and developing maturity, the wine is going to be ready from 2025.

Based on 75% Merlot and 25% Cabernet Sauvignon from vines just outside the village of Cadillac, the 2019 Chateau Haut-La-Pereyre has a classic Bordeaux nose of ripe cherries and blackberries as well as lots of cedary herbs, violets, and spicy aromas and flavors. It's medium-bodied, has som firm yet ripe tannins, good balance, and lots of character. I suspect it will be a great value.

Now in its sixth generation of ownership by the same family, this estate in the Haut-Benauge region overlooks the Garonne valley. This wine is full and rich, reflecting the weight of the year, bringing out tannins, juicy black fruits as well as a bite of pepper from alcohol. The wine will be ready from 2021.
