Riesling Berg 2022

The 2022 Riesling Berg was harvested in late September on four different plots, all vinified in separate tanks. The slightest flicker of reduction still informs a subtle note of herb accompanying pure, ripe apple flesh with a notion of freshness that hovers promisingly. The palate is bright and vivid, slender with a lovely notion of fresh apple and the crushed herbs of mountain meadows. Beautifully precise and clear-cut on a slender, fresh, juicy palate. (Bone-Dry)

Riesling Berg 2021

Complex nose of fresh and candied lemon with notes of fresh almonds and wet stones. At once generous and vibrant, this youthful dry riesling opens quickly in the glass. Wonderful texture on the concentrated and precise palate, it's at the bottom end of full-bodied, but very cool and refined. Very pure crystalline finish. Matured for more than a year on the lees in stainless steel tank.
