



PAVILLON DE CHAVANNES BEAUJOLAIS BLANC

Since 1861 the Jambon family has run Pavillon de Chavannes, a domaine renowned for its toothsome stony red Beaujolais from the heights of Mt. Brouilly (the *côte* in Côte de Brouilly). In 2020 Laure Jambon took the reins from her father. A fierce partisan of Chardonnay grown on Beaujolais' granitic soils, she expanded the domaine's range to include a bit of Beaujolais Blanc.



VINEYARD

- Site:** On the opposing hillside from Mt. Brouilly. It faces east, looking across the valley to the domaine on its western flank of Mt. Brouilly.
- Soil:** Thin, sandy marls overtop of granite bedrock.
- Vines:** From one acre of vines planted five years ago. *Lutte raisonnée* farming. Hand harvested.
- Varieties:** Chardonnay.

CELLAR

- Vinification & Aging:** Destemmed but not crushed, fermented whole berry in concrete and raised over winter mostly in steel but with about a third in neutral barrels.
- Production:** 150 cases.
- Profile:** A fresh, floral and lively Chardonnay full of yellow fruits.
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
