## Meursault

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### Meursault Les Pellans 2021

*The 2021 Meursault “les Pellans” from winemaker Isabelle Laurand at Parcelles de Saulx is an excellent wine. The bouquet is bright, precise and complex, wafting from the glass in a blend of pear, passion fruit, iodine, hazelnuts, a fine base of soil tones, geraniums and a nice touch of oak. On the palate the wine is vibrant, full-bodied, focused and complex, with lovely depth of fruit, fine soil inflection, bright acids and lovely balance on the long and classy finish. This is first class Meursault AC! 2024-2045.*

### Gevrey-Chambertin Les Evocelles 2021

*The 2021 les Evocelles from winemaker Isabelle Laurand at the micro-négociant of Parcelles de Saulx in Meursault was raised entirely in a “one wine” cask of three hundred liters. The wine is deep and refined on the nose, offering up scents of red plums, black cherries, bonfire, gamebird, dark soil tones and a gentle foundation of nutty oak. On the palate the wine is pure, nascently complex and full-bodied, with fine depth of fruit, lovely soil signature, buried, seamless tannins and a long, vibrant and beautifully balanced finish. This is an exquisite example of the fine terroir of les Evocelles! 2031-2075.*

*Here too the wood treatment is subtle but not invisible on the cool, airy and elegant aromas of red currant, earth, sauvage and crushed anise scents. There is fine density and punch to the medium weight flavors that possess a sophisticated texture along with an evident bead of minerality on the delicious and sneaky long finish. This is a very fine Gevrey villages that is worth your interest.*

## **Gevrey-Chambertin Les Corbeaux 2021**

*The 2021 les Corbeaux from Parcelles de Saulx is a superb example of this fine premier cru. There is only a single cask of this in 2021 from Isabelle and her team, but it is very special indeed! The bouquet is precise, complex and already nicely expressive, wafting from the glass in a mix of plums, cherries, smoked meats, a nice touch of sweet stem tones, cocoa powder, a fine base of soil, gentle spice tones, smoke and cedary oak. On the palate the wine is bright, full-bodied, focused and tangy, with a beautiful core of fruit, lovely transparency and grip, ripe, buried tannins and impeccable balance on the long and complex finish. I love the backend lift here on the finish. This is a very elegant rendition of les Corbeaux and will be a gorgeous glass of Gevrey in a decade or so! 2034-2085+.*

## **Vosne-Romanée 2021**

*There is only a single barrel of the 2021 Vosne-Romanée AC from Parcelles de Saulx. The wine is lovely on both the nose and palate, with the bouquet wafting from the glass in a complex blend of red and black raspberries, gamebird, raw cocoa, woodsmoke, lovely soil tones, Vosne spices, a touch of sweet stem tones and a gentle framing of nutty oak from its older cask. On the palate the wine is bright, full-bodied and tangy, with a fine core of fruit, superb soil inflection and grip, ripe tannins and a long, complex and very nicely balanced finish. This is an excellent villages! 2032-2075.*

## **Nuits St Georges Les Murgers 2021**

*The 2021 Nuits St. Georges “les Murgers” from Parcelles de Saulx was raised entirely in a “one wine” barrel in this vintage. The wine is already beautifully expressive on both the nose and palate, with the bouquet soaring from the glass in a complex mix of cherries, red plum, a touch of blood orange, nutskin, a complex base of soil, gentle spice tones, pigeon and cedary oak. On the palate the wine is full-bodied, focused and complex, with a beautiful core of red fruit, excellent soil undertow and grip, ripe, well-integrated tannins, tangy acids and lovely balance on the long, vibrant finish. This is a proper premier cru from Nuits and will need plenty of cellaring before it is ready to drink, but it is going to be superb juice in the fullness of time. 2036-2085+.*
