



Chardonnay “Sojeau Vineyard” Eola-Amity Hills 2022

The 2022 Chardonnay Sojeau Vineyard is understated in the glass, displaying a nuanced blend of honeyed florals, yellow apples, hints of ginger and iodine. It’s juicy upon entry, with salty minerals to balance as ripe orchard fruits swirl throughout, all guided by brisk acidity. It leaves a gentle tension to linger through the subtly tannic finale as notes of sour citrus fade.

Chardonnay Willamette Valley 2022

The 2022 Chardonnay Willamette Valley is perfumed in the glass, revealing a sweetly floral blend of chamomile, Asian pear and white flowers. This is a soft and round effort with ripe orchard fruits and a sensation of liquid stone, giving way to an air of sage toward the close. It finishes youthfully tense, with a bitter lemon-rind tinge and crunchy minerals that linger on.

Pinot Noir Willamette Valley 2022

Wild and woody, the 2022 Pinot Noir Willamette Valley bursts from the glass with an enticing mix of wild berries, pine shavings, rubbed sage and a dusting of spice. This is rounded in feel, with a balanced inner sweetness and crisp red fruits that flow across a tension-building brisk acidity. Pleasantly chewy and exceptionally long, the 2022 leaves a sweet-and-sour sensation that keeps this taster looking back at the glass for more.

Pinot Noir Polk County 2022

The 2022 Pinot Noir Polk County Cuvée is dusty and understated, opening with a pretty mix of dried roses, licorice and ground cloves. This is a juicy and energetic effort, with ripe red berry fruits lifted by zesty acidity as violet inner florals amass toward the close. A web of fine-grained tannins adds youthful poise as the 2022 finishes long and gently structured, leaving a tart raspberry concentration to fade slowly.

Pinot Noir Sojeau Vineyard 2022

The 2022 Pinot Noir Sojeau is darkly floral and exotic as crushed ashen stones and dried roses come together with hints of tangerine and red currants. Seamlessly silky yet also decidedly savory in style, this quickly builds tension as a wave of mineral-drenched wild berry fruits saturates, leaving a resonance of licorice toward the close. The 2022 finishes long and potent with a lingering primary concentration, neatly framed by silty tannins that add youthful poise without slowing the wine's momentum.

Pinot Noir Temperance Hill 2022

The 2022 Pinot Noir Temperance Hill is a spice box on the nose, with crushed rocks, flint, ground cloves, rosemary, sage and dried strawberries forming its kaleidoscopic bouquet. It's round and soft-textured, with juicy acidity and depths of ripe wild berry fruits that swirl across a core of tactile minerals. Hints of white pepper add a lovely contrast toward the close. The 2022 becomes spicy through the gently tannic finish as a bitter tinge of blackberry lingers alongside notes of licorice. This is the first bottling of Temperance Hill from Violin. It was refined in 20% new oak.

Pinot Noir Justice Vineyard 2022

The 2022 Pinot Noir Justice Vineyard pulls the taster down to the earth with a blend of woodland berries, cedar shavings, _sous bois) and camphor. This is surprisingly juicy and energetic within, with masses of ripe red and blue fruits that swirl across a core of vibrant acidity as crunchy minerals form toward the close. The 2022 leaves the palate reeling with youthful tension as violet inner florals and sweet spices resonate over a coating of crisp tannins. This is a beautiful rendition of Justice Vineyard—made without new oak.
