



## DEOVLET PINOT GRIGIO RAMATO

### “THIS TIME TOMORROW”

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Ryan Deovlet has garnered a reputation as a star exemplifying the best of the new breed of California winemakers. He’s dialed back on new oak and extractions, he’s comfortable being among the first to start the harvest, and he concentrates on the vineyards in the Santa Rita Hills to learn their ways.

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#### VINEYARD

**Site:** Edna Valley  
**Soil:** Loamy clay.  
**Vines:** Hand harvested.  
**Varieties:** Pinot Grigio.

#### CELLAR

**Vinification & Aging:** Made using extended skin contact for eight months and then aged in a combination of sandstone amphora and 400L barrels—a Santa Barbara version of ‘ramato’ (Italian for ‘copper’). Unfined and unfiltered with only a small addition of sulfur before bottling.

**Profile:** Great balance and depth with a mineral-driven tactile nuance which suggests orchard fruit skin and presents a slight chalky texture.

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
