



Cabernet Sauvignon Star Lane Vineyard 2021

All varietal, the 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon Star Lane Vineyard comes from the Happy Canyon region and was aged 22 months in 50% new French oak. Its deep ruby/plum color is followed by solid aromatics of ripe black fruit, leafy herbs, chocolate, and some leather and underbrush-like nuances. This medium-bodied, nicely concentrated, balanced Cabernet has quality tannins, good overall balance, and outstanding length. It should evolve for two decades.

The 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon Star Lane Vineyard is a deep, potent wine from this Happy Canyon site. Dark cherry, plum, licorice, spice, herbs and gravel fill out the layers. This savory Santa Barbara Cabernet Sauvignon will drink well for the next handful of years, maybe more.

Cabernet Sauvignon Star Lane Vineyard 2020

The 2020 Cabernet Sauvignon Star Lane Vineyard is another compelling old-school wine from Ryan Deovlet. Picking on the early side preserves notable freshness and verve. Grilled herbs, new leather, licorice, bay leaf, rose petal, menthol and dried autumn leaves add layers of nuance to a core of dark red/purplish fruit. It's a Cabernet for readers who enjoy classically austere wines, in the best sense of that term.
