



DONATIEN BAHUAUD CABERNET FRANC

The wines of Donatien Bahuaud (previously bottled under the Charles Bove label) are the product of a top-notch Loire Valley négociant with a base of operations in an enormous rock quarry, burrowed into a chalk hillside for limestone to build the Loire châteaux. The firm specializes in buying grape must or juice direct from surrounding domaines and then vinifying, blending, and bottling in this vast old quarry.



VINEYARD

- Site:** From the eastern edge of Anjou in the Brissac zone, across the Loire and southeast of Angers.
- Soil:** Black schist soils.
- Vines:** From a selection of parcels in Anjou.
- Varieties:** Cabernet Franc.

CELLAR

- Vinification & Aging:** A short maceration and aging in steel over winter to give emphasis to purity and fruit.
- Production:** ~3,500 cases.
- Profile:** A quintessential central Loire Cab Franc with ample fruit and fresh aromatics at a price that will leave change in your pocket.
