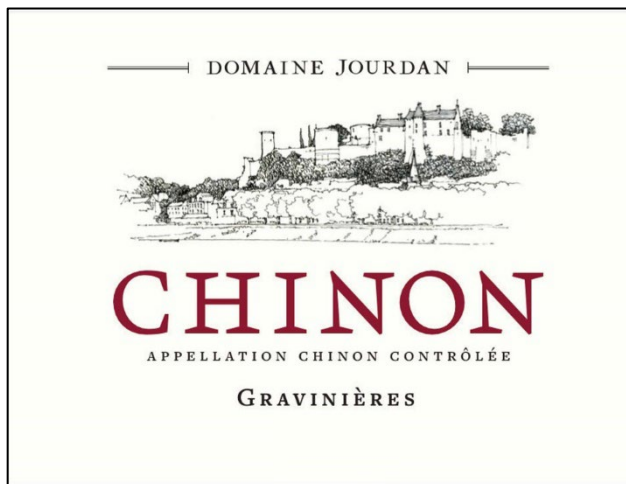


# Domaine Jourdan

### Chinon “Gravinières” 2021

*This is a delicious, organically-farmed Chinon! Attractive black plum dusted with pencil shavings leads on the nose with a bouquet of white flowers in tow. Red fruit and an energetic acidity run hand in hand through the length of the taste that gives raspberry herbal tea on the finish.*

*The Chinon “Gravinières” bottling from Domaine Jourdan is crafted from several parcels of vines planted on gravelly soils near the Vienne River. The wine is fermented in stainless steel and aged in cement vats. The 2021 Gravinières is a beautiful young bottle of Chinon, offering up a deep and complex bouquet of cassis, black cherries, cigar ash, tree bark, gravelly soil tones and a nice touch of upper register smokiness. On the palate the wine is bright, full-bodied and wide open in personality, with lovely depth at the core, good soil undertow and grip, suave, moderate tannins and a long, complex and easy-going finish. This is drinking very nicely out of the blocks, but also has the underlying structure to age and nicely grow in the bottle. Good juice. 2023-2040+.*
