



## LES PARCELLAIRES DE SAULX

### MEURSAULT LE PRÉ DE MANCHE

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Les Parcellaires de Saulx is a small *maison de vins* going back to 1908. Native Burgundian Isabelle Laurand has been the cellar master since the turn of the century. She has a strict focus on single-site wines from single producers, all of whom she knows on a first-name basis, and unlike traditional *négociants*, she doesn't blend.

Her focus is on organic, biodynamic and conscientiously sustainable growers. Every wine is raised in predominantly older wood to let its fruit and soil notes shine, and for most only a handful of barrels are produced.

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#### VINEYARD

- Site:** *Pré de Manche* originally referred to stone outcroppings forming a rough line of steps up the parcel. The downslope, eastern edge touches Les Cras but for a road separating them, and it lies on the border with Volnay just over the line from Volnay's Les Caillerets.
- Soil:** Particularly rocky, especially further up the slope.
- Vines:** This plot was replanted in 1971. Subsequent replantings have been done vine by vine when needed, meaning the average age is quite old.
- Varieties:** Chardonnay.

#### CELLAR

- Vinification & Aging:** Aged 12-15 months in predominantly older wood.
- Production:** Typically three barrels, or 150/ 6-packs.
- Profile:** A weighty, generous wine tempered by mineral acidity.
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
