Petit Chablis 2023

Léa Schaller only took over the small family domaine in the village of Préhy in 2019, having slowly started to take back some of the family's vineyards from the cooperative. She only bottles two wines, her Chablis villages and her Petit Chablis, with her vineyards harvested by machine. Here 2023 Petit Chablis is really quite a lovely wine, offering up a bright and complex bouquet of green apple, pear, chalky minerality, white flowers and a touch of beeswax in the upper register. On the palate the wine is bright, full-bodied, focused and complex, with an excellent core of fruit, fine mineral undertow and grip, a very good girdle of acidity and a long, well balanced and nicely precise finish. This is a very impressive example of Petit Chablis! 2025-2035.
