



PIERRE JEAN VILLA SAINT-JOSEPH TILDÉ

*certified organic

After seven years of managing and making the wine at the Vins de Viennes winery, Pierre Jean Villa started his own domaine in 2009 from scratch. He resurrected vineyards and embarked on finding a truly viable organic viticulture for his steep hillsides. He has 42 acres of vines and has been joined at the domaine by his son and daughter.



VINEYARD

- Site:** The vines are in the very center of the Saint-Joseph appellation in the commune of Sarras.
- Elevation:** Roughly 300 meters in altitude, high on the hillside.
- Soil:** Sandy soils on top of a mother rock of pure granite.
- Vines:** From four parcels close to each other of old vines planted in 1963, 1964, 1965 and 1970 totaling 2.5 acres. *Certified organic in France by Ecocert but not in the US by USDA.
- Varieties:** Syrah.

CELLAR

- Vinification & Aging:** As much as 60% of the wine is fermented with whole stems. Aged in a mix of 225L and 500L barrels, all older, for up to 24 months.
- Production:** 500 six-packs.
- Profile:** Deep, dark and dense with stunningly pure and classic Saint-Joseph black fruits. *Tildé* refers to the Spanish accent mark, which forms the logo on Pierre Jean's labels.
