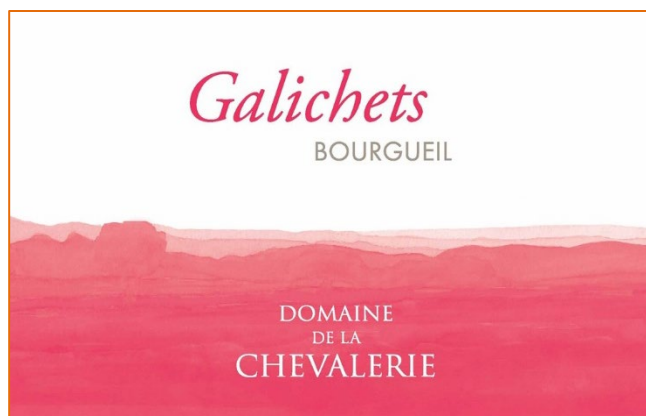


Domaine de la Chevalerie Bourgueil

The 2019 Les Galichets is a rich, focused and compact style with intensity and richness woven into its less-than-medium body. The fine-grained tannins are well handled and the finish is refreshing...Black cherry fruits, plums and spices linger on the medium-long finish.

Bourgueil “Les Galichets” 2018

Emmanuel Caslot and his sister Laurie continue with love and rigor the work of thirteen generations of this historic Bourgueil estate. On the 33 hectares certified biodynamic, the Cabernet Franc is vinified with real gentleness to express in a nuanced way the terroirs of sand, clay and limestone of low, mid and high altitudes. A lovely 2018 from Galichets which brilliantly evokes the solar concentration of the vintage through dark aromas of black fruits and spices, without falling into excessive illustration. With a touch that is both soothing and energetic, this is a great wine to keep at the beginning of its life.

Bourgueil “Les Galichets” 2017

Hailing from 45 -year-old vines that have their feet in gravels of a former river bed, the 2017 Galichets is savory yet shows mushroom, smoky, red cherry fruit. Classically styled but it just has the right ripeness - not overdone. Delightfully textured. Light on its feet but with plenty of concentration.
