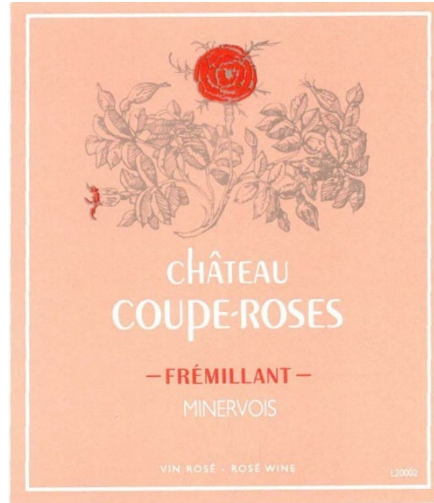


Château Coupe Roses Minervois



Minervois Frémillant Rosé 2024

The 2024 Minervois Rosé “Fremillant” from Château Coupe-Roses is made from a complex cépages of forty percent mourvèdre, thirty percent cinsault, twenty percent grenache and ten percent syrah. The wine is a lovely salmon color and offers up loads of personality in its bouquet of white cherries, tangerine, a gentle touch of both garrigue and dried eucalyptus, stony soil tones, orange peel and a topnote of dried flowers. On the palate the wine is bright, full-bodied and focused, with a good core and soil undertow, sound framing acids and a long, well balanced finish. Fine juice, but it is a touch on the soft side and will best be drunk up in the next couple of years. 2025-2027.
