La Encantada Pinot Blanc 2023

The 2023 Pinot Blanc La Encantada Vineyard is aged in a combination of neutral wood, sandstone amphora and stainless steel. Very minty and cool-toned in feel, it balances varietal grip and texture with generous body and energy. Pink peppercorn, lavender and ginger lend tons of complexity and intrigue. This is such a distinctive wine, especially within the context of the Sta. Rita Hills, but you still feel the signature of the region through the salty verve on the finish.

La Encantada Pinot Noir 2023

The most intense and multifaceted Pinot Noir of the Deovlet roster is the 2023 Pinot Noir La Encantada Vineyard, which bounds from the glass with a gorgeous nose of black cherries, bergamot, dried citrus peels and oyster shells that develops floral overtones as it aerates. The palate fuses a slender elasticity with weightless richness, transitioning into a soaring, fine-boned finish propelled by refined tannins and marine overtones. This is incredibly dynamic in the glass, and I suspect it will take on greater complexity after a few more years in bottle.

The 2023 Pinot Noir La Encantada Vineyard impresses most with its exceptional focus and density through the mid-palate. Pomegranate, orange zest, violet and crushed rocks add to an impression of restrained power. The structure is particularly polished, but it's formidable. Slightly longer aging of 16-18 months in once-used oak was just what the doctor ordered.
