Pinot Noir Temperance Hill Vineyard Pumphouse Block, Eola-Amity Hills 2022

The Pumphouse Block at Temperance Hill was planted in 1994 on a steep, eastern-facing slope. The aromatics are wound a bit tightly on opening but evolve over the course of a few hours. There's electricity and minerality in the offering as crunchy red raspberries, mint leaves and an edge of ocean salt air all bound from the glass over time. The palate shows a steely tension, raspberry leaf, briny seafoam and crisp red fruits. Fresh cranberries, spiced orange peel, evergreen bough and freshly chopped mint. It's a gorgeous, glorious bottle of wine.

Pinot Noir Whistling Ridge Vineyard, Ribbon Ridge 2022

From Ribbon Ridge, the jeweled ruby-colored 2022 Pinot Noir Whistling Ridge Vineyard is packed with ripe red cherry fruit, gravelly, iron-rich earth, anise, a hint of violets, and wild herbs. Medium-bodied, it offers ripe tannins, even acidity, and a note of salty mineral earth. Drink 2025-2040

Pinot Noir Durant Vineyard, Dundee Hills 2022

The 2022 Pinot Noir Durant entices with a sweetly spiced bouquet of wild blueberries, sweet herbs and hints of cinnamon spice. This is juicy and round, with perfumed wild berry fruits elevated by blood orange as bright-toned inner florals resonate throughout. It leaves a tactile staining of minerality and gently grippy tannins, finishing with a tinge of sour citrus that lingers on.

Chardonnay Temperance Hill, Eola-Amity Hills 2022

Intense in the glass, the bright yellow/silver colored 2022 Chardonnay Temperance Hill Vineyard has a forward note of reduction in the glass that I love and reveals notes of toast, white pepper, lime zest, green apples, and white flowers. It has great electric energy balanced with rich extract and a fantastic stony texture, with a balanced feel through its long finish. It's going to benefit from another year or two to flesh out, then drink it over the following 12 or so few years. I love this wine.

Intense in the glass, the 2022 Chardonnay Temperance Hill opens with a whiff of crushed rocks, flint and dusty sage, giving way to freshly sliced nectarines. This is texturally thrilling, silken and supple with depths of ripe pit fruits complicated by saline minerals. A bump of zesty acidity maintains fantastic freshness, leaving hints of sour lime and a green apple crunchiness.
