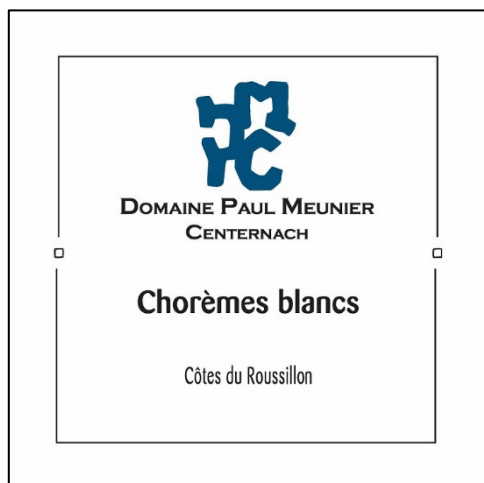


Domaine Paul Meunier Centernach, Roussillon

[T]he wine is deep, full-bodied, focused and complex, with a lovely core of fruit, excellent soil signature, sound framing acids and a long, beautifully balanced finish. A lovely bottle. 2025-2030.

This white blend (which is cofermented in amphora and stainless steel) catwalks across your senses. The nose delivers power and restraint with nectarine, golden apple, honeydew melon and kumquat zest all playing well together. The palate echoes the nose with yellow-orchard-fruit-expressiveness along with the faintest hint of ginger peel on the finish.

Smells of wild honey and mountain herbs, chypre and cistus. The texture, which is the first thing that fills the senses, feels like hand-made cotton paper in its crisp yet tensile, fibrous strength, and the way it makes the colours of the wine appear richer and deeper, the way it carries the watermark of the vineyard...It is a wine worth complete attention.
