

Domaine Ollier-Taillefer Faugères



Tournée Générale 2024

The Faugères “Tournée Générale” bottling from Domaine Ollier Taillefer is made from twenty-five percent each of carignan, cinsault, grenache and syrah. It is a new cuvée for the estate, first crafted in 2023, with the wine fermented and raised in stainless steel tank and bottled without SO2 to appeal to the wine hipster crowd. The 2024 comes in at an event thirteen percent octane and offers up a lovely and wide open nose of cassis, dark berries, woodsmoke, hung game, brown spices, a touch of pepper and a lovely base of soil. On the palate the wine is full-bodied, complex and really well balanced, with a fine core of fruit, moderate, ripe tannins, tangy acids and lovely focus on the long and impressively complex finish. If more low sulfur bottlings were this good, I would count myself among the wine hipster crowd! 2025-2035+.
