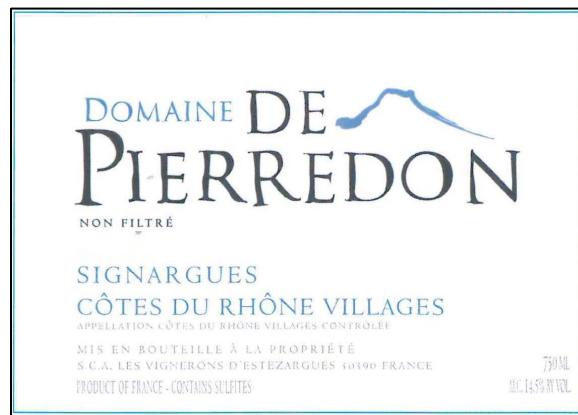


Domaine de Pierredon

Côtes du Rhône



Côtes du Rhône-Villages “Signargues” 2023

The plateau of Signargues lies just east of Avignon, with the same soils as those found in Châteauneuf du Pape, loaded with les galets roulés. Domaine de la Pierredon’s wine is composed of a fifty-fifty blend of grenache and mourvèdre, hailing from organically-farmed vineyards. The wine is fermented with indigenous yeasts and raised in vats. The wine comes in at fifteen percent octane in 2023 and offers up a complex nose of dark berries, hung game, pepper, coffee grounds, campfire, stony soil tones and a gentle topnote of garrigue. On the palate the wine is deep, full-bodied, ripe and complex, with a fine core of fruit, good soil undertow, moderate, chewy tannins and just a bit of backend heat poking out on the long finish. Good juice. 2025-2035.
